
books mirror the books read in school and offer an alternative or an addition to the school's reading scheme. They can be read on laptops, desktops, tablets, iPads and most smartphones.

To begin with your child should come home with a login card or sticker. It will look like this.





You can log onto the website using this link <https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/> or you can search Oxford Owl on google.


You will get to a page that looks like this.

You can do a quick search by age group, or by type of books (series). The best way to ensure your child/ren get the right book is by level. Your child's teacher will let you know what level or colour book to read or you can use the grid below.

Here, the partner texts are designed for an adult to read one side of the page, and the child to read the other. This way, your child gets to hear richer and more complex language during the adult part, and then has the satisfaction of being able to read their part at their own level. You will need the book from school to be able to use this but you can just listen and enjoy if you don't have one.

These books are linked to phonics (letter sounds) and can help your child if they are still learning to read. Your child's teacher will tell you what colour level will be suitable for your child.
