| Shoes | <p>Black smart and sensible – plain black trainers and fuss free ankle boots are allowed. All shoes should be suitable for outdoor play in all weathers. Please do not buy heels or slip-on ballet pump style.</p> | |
| Bags | <p>Pupils DO NOT need rucksacks - we do not have the storage capacity for them.</p>  | <p>Pupils may bring a school book bag or traditional drawstring PE bag</p>   |
| Lunch boxes |  <p>Small lunch box or bag which fits a drink bottle. We do not have the storage capacity for large bags or rucksacks.</p> | |

| <p>Water bottles</p> | <p>All new starters are given a 500ml water bottle free of charge. These fit our classroom storage holders. Please do not send large alternatives. The bottles stay in classrooms during the day.</p> <p>Replacement lids are available for 55p or new bottles for £1.35.</p> <p>WATER ONLY – if a pupil brings juice/squash they will be offered two choices:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Save until home time and use school cups instead 2) Pour it away and refill with water <p>Pupils on packed lunches need a separate drink to accompany their food.</p> | |
| <p>Jewellery</p> | <p>Ideally NO jewellery should be worn to school but, if necessary, we will permit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Small gold stud earrings · Sikh Kara bracelets · Wrist watch <p>We apply advice from the PE Association to daily life in school as the children are physically active throughout the day.</p> | <p>EARRINGS</p> <p>School adults WILL NOT remove earrings for a child.</p> <p>If a pupil is sent to school in earrings it may be necessary to exclude them from elements of lessons and playtimes.</p> <p>If you feel there is a genuine reason why your child cannot remove jewellery or stick to policy please send them to school with tape over their earrings.</p> |
