Year 1 have been practising their happy breathing whilst doing our happy mind lessons.

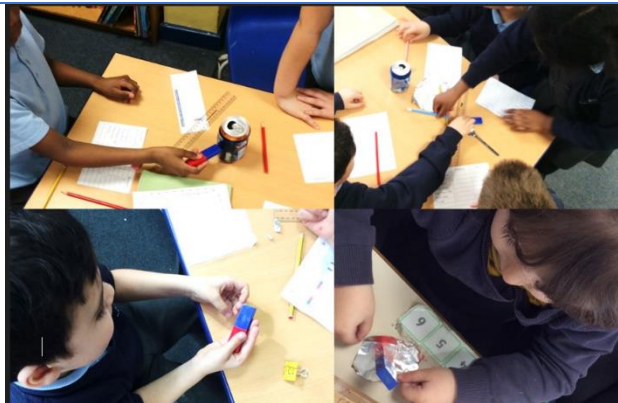


Year 2
